TO ROBERT F. KENNEDY JR. & PRESIDENT DONALD J. TRUMP

LET LIBERTY SPEAK

For Immediate Release: WASHINGTON, D.C., May 5, 2024 —: At around noon Central Standard Time, Robert Kennedy Jr. took to X (Twitter) and posted a challenge to former President Donald J. Trump to a debate at the Libertarian National Convention on May 24th and 25th. Saying:

“So I’d like to make you an offer. We’re both going to be speaking at the upcoming Libertarian convention on May 24 and 25. It’s perfect neutral territory for you and me to have a debate where you can defend your record for your wavering supporters. You yourself have said you’re not afraid to debate me so as long as my poll numbers are decent. Well, they are. In fact, I’m the only presidential candidate in history who has polled ahead of both major party candidates in head-to-head races.”

Counter Proposal: In a letter from Mike ter Maat to RFK and Donald Trump that was written today, May 7, 2024:

“In response to your Tweet to Donald Trump on May 7, 2024, I would like to propose a debate, this debate would include just the three of us. In the interest of bringing resolution to this consideration once and for all, and to do so before our convention begins May 23rd, I propose a public debate. This discussion would focus on policy principles, proposed solutions to our most pressing challenges, and our respective visions for a nation we love dearly.”

If you are going to come to the Libertarian Convention and propose a debate, you should include a Libertarian candidate.
